Anti-Bribery Policy
and not accepting gifts, gifts, or any other benefits. (No Gift Policy)

According to the Organic Act on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. 2561, Section 128, paragraph one. It has stipulated that no public officer shall receive property or any other benefit which may be calculated as money from anyone. Other than property or benefits that should be obtained by law. Rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of law, except for the receipt of property or other benefits by virtue of the Code of Conduct. NCC Regulations and Code of Ethics Police Commissioner B.E. 2564 (2) Article 2(2) Honesty and Integrity Perform legal duties The National Police Bureau's formalities are transparent and do not show behavior that implies wrongful exploitation. Responsible for human rights duties Be ready for audit and liability Have a good conscience. and Article 2(4) Think of the common good rather than personal interests, have a public spirit, cooperate, cooperate, and sacrifice in contributing to the common good and creating happiness for society. Establish important reform activities Activity 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and useless Goal 1 1.1 for all government agencies The declaration is an agency where all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind. From duty (No Gift Policy)

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts of interest, bribes, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, it is prescribed method Anti-Bribery Policy and No Gift Policy from performing duties are as follows:

Article 1 This Notice

"Commanding Officer" means a person who has the authority to direct, supervise, monitor and inspect police officers under his subordinate officers.

"Bribe" means property or any other benefit given to a person to induce that person. Act or not act in any way in office. Whether it is right or wrong, with duty.

"Performance" means the act or performance of duties of a public official. In a position appointed or assigned to perform a particular function. or to act in accordance with any of the duties, both general and specific, as a police officer as prescribed by law.- 2 -

"The gift of aN means money, property, services or any other benefit of value and including tips received by public officials in addition to salary, income, benefits from the government in normal cases and affecting decision-making, approval, authorization or otherwise in the performance of duties in a manner that favors dishonestly the gift giver either in the past or at the time of receiving or in the future.

Article 2 Police officers at all levels shall conduct themselves. as follows

1. Do not ask for advice, do not give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits from the practice. duty
2. Do not consent or knowingly allow family members to give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits to those involved in the performance of their duties.
3. The performance of duties must adhere to law enforcement with fairness and take the interests and image of the police as priority. Must not commit any act that conflicts between personal interests and public interests, such as accepting gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties. Use of government resources for personal gain, disclosure of internal information Crowding office hours for extra work, etc.
4. Reduce the giving or receiving of property or other benefits by virtue of the Code of Conduct in accordance with the rules and regulations of the office. The NCC requires that people use a method of expression by signing greeting cards, greeting books, condolence cards, or using social media instead of giving things.
5. Refusal Not resistant. Not indifferent. to the behavior of accepting bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits. If any violation is found, the superintendent/station chief shall be notified as soon as possible.

Article 3 The supervisor shall have the authority and duty to supervise, monitor and inspect the police officers under the department to comply with this announcement. In the event that an act is found in violation of this notice, the Superintendent shall report it. The station chief will know ASAP.

Article 4 Whoever finds an act in violation of this Notice Complaints/whistleblowing can be made directly to the Superintendent of Sawang Weerawong Police Station at Sawang Weerawong Police Station or by phone 083 7226097 where the information of the complainant/whistleblower will be kept and kept strictly confidential.

Article 5 In case of receiving complaints/clues Personnel under the department committed such offences at the police station. Fact-checking will be carried out. And if found guilty, such offender will be punished according to the law. Strictly comply with relevant rules and regulations, and submit matters according to the hierarchy. Further command
